Bea also suggested Steve Halley from the Family Peace Initiative (familypeaceinitiative.com) in Kanas who has a facilitator training series. Donavan agreed to explore Mr. Halley as an option for the conference. A discussion began regarding if the conference should be multiple days or possibly biannual. A planning subcommittee for the conference was formed comprised of Donavan, Patricia, Lea, and Kathleen will be reached out to as well.

V. NC Council for Women/DV Commission Update: Donavan reported in Kathleen Balough's absence an update regarding the current rules governing BIP's in NC. There were no public comments added into the rules, it is currently under review to be finalized in the Office of Administrative Courts.
